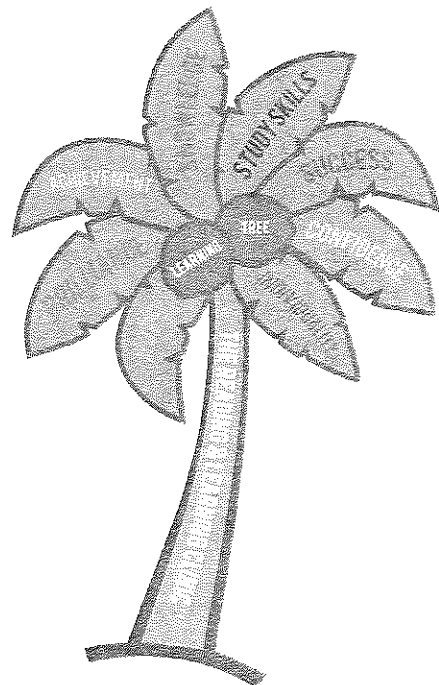

## 7. SAT Class (For August 24th Test Date) 11th & 12th Graders

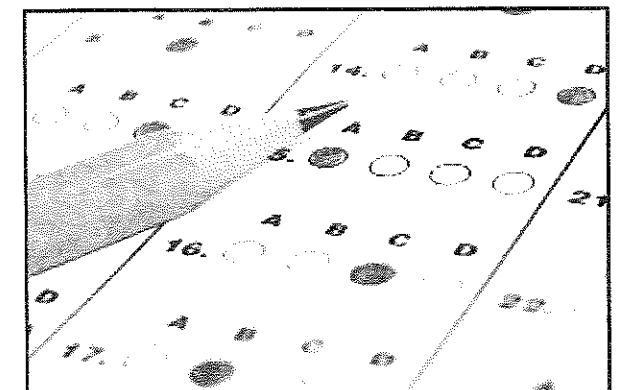
- 8 to 10 students per group
